What:	National Field Archery Assoc. & National Archery Association Certification Certification valid for 3 years. Practical and multiple-choice exam req'd to pass.
Who:	Boy Scout, Venturing and Explorer leaders only. Must be 18 years of age. (minimum of 10 participants; maximum of 25)
Why:	Course will allow you to: train Boy Scouts or Venturing Scouts at BSA approved range, work towards archery merit badge or just to experience archery.
When:	May 2-3, 2008 – Begins Friday night at 6:00 PM (supper will NOT be provided) and ends on Saturday at 6:00 PM
Where:	Camp Durant Scout Reservation (near Carthage, NC)
Cost:	\$95 - Includes all supplies and Breakfast & Lunch on Saturday. (\$25 of the \$95 is a non-refundable fee for exam, materials and cancellations)
